



I-CISK Climate Services in Andalusia-Los Pedroches Living Lab

CS1: Monthly weather forecasts for temperature and precipitation for the next 6 months at a spatial resolution of 250 m.

CS2: Monthly climate projections for temperature and precipitation at a spatial scale of 1 km for the **next 15 years**.


CS3: Historical climate records from official stations and continuous maps (250 m) covering the LL area.

CS4: Agroclimatic indicators and prediction of the impact of climate projections on olive crop production.

CS5: Hydrogeological characterization of the Los Pedroches aquifer.


