### **3M Corporation**

## Pollution Prevention Pays (PPP) program Worldwide 1975 - 1990 (15 years)

- 126,000 tons of air pollutants
- 16,600 tons of sludge
- 6,600 m3 of wastewater
- 409,000 tons of solid/hazardous waste
- 210,000 barrels of oil annually
- US \$ 506,000,000 in 15 years

#### Química y Textiles Proquindus

| Action                             | Cost<br>(US\$) | Savings<br>(US\$/y) | Payback<br>period |
|------------------------------------|----------------|---------------------|-------------------|
| Replace leaking steam traps        | 700            | 47,000              | 1 week            |
| Modifying rinsing procedures       | 400            | 45,000              | < 1 week          |
| Replace sulphate with NaCl         | none           | 7,500               | immediate         |
| Repair leaks in wool laundries     | 50             | 3,700               | < 1 week          |
| Repair leaks on Zonco washer       | none           | 2,200               | immediate         |
| Filter sulphuric acid continuously | 700            | 300                 | 2.5 years         |
| TOTAL                              | 1,850          | > 100,000           |                   |

| Cerveceria SA | Reutilization of<br>Filtration Material                          | 7681                       | 2.3                            |
| Plastigama SA | Various small<br>corrective material<br>expenditures             | 9100                       | 5.7                            |
| Plastigama SA | System for the<br>management of<br>raw and composite<br>material | 900,000                    | 9                              |
